The camp is located at Talbot Park at Bayview and Eglinton and will take place for 10 weeks over the last week of June to the third week of August, inclusive. Camp operates daily from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (with extended care available until 4:30 pm) Monday to Friday.

Responsibilities and Duties

As a Counsellor-in-Training (CIT), you are part of the Leaside Baseball Camp because of your desire to work with children, your creativity and enthusiasm, and because we believe you will have a positive impact on our campers. When you choose to be a CIT, you accept the responsibility to be a role model for these kids and are part of a team that will provide a supportive and safe environment.

The CIT is responsible for the following:

- Assist Counselors with set up of drills and activities that teach campers proper baseball movements, techniques, and etiquette through age-appropriate activities (this will be taught to Counsellors who don't have baseball experience)
- Set up and clean-up equipment before and after programming, and ensure the camp is kept clean, organized, and free of litter

The CIT is to have the following experience and skills:

- A friendly and outgoing personality that makes you passionate about working with kids and are eager to make their camp experience a great one
- Energy and enthusiasm, bringing a positive energy to the camp everyday
- A strong work ethic that makes you reliable, punctual, professional and motivated
- Ability to work in a team environment as well as independently
- Able to listen to and follow instructions
- Experience with competitive baseball as a player or umpire is a plus
- Age 13+
