About Our Summer Camp

Our Baseball camp is a summer day camp for boys and girls ages 5 to 13 for the Minor and Major League Camps and ages 12 to 16 for the Elite Camp. We welcome players with all degrees of baseball experience. The camp is located at Talbot Park at Bayview and Eglinton and will take place during the July and August summer season. Camp operates daily from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (with extended care available until 4:30 pm) Monday to Friday.

Minor League campers are 5 to 8 years old and will have varying degrees of camp, athletic, and baseball experience. While we are a baseball camp, the primary focus of this camp segment is to promote athletic development in a fun and encouraging environment.

Responsibilities and Duties in Minor League Camp

As a Counsellor with the Minor League camp, you are part of our team because of your desire to work with children, your creativity and enthusiasm, and because we believe you will have a positive impact on our campers. When you choose to be a Counsellor, you accept the responsibility to be a role model for these kids and are part of a team that will provide a supportive and safe environment.

The Camp Counsellor is responsible for the following:

- Assist with the onboarding and outboarding of campers each day, including interacting with campers and parents in a professional manner and facilitating the necessary administrative tasks
- Lead various age appropriate activities that introduce and promote athletic movements, techniques, and etiquette to groups of kids ensuring safe play, respect, and fun
- Take responsibility for the general health and safety of the campers by
 - Providing care and comfort to upset, distraught, or homesick campers
 - Handling peer to peer interactions
 - o Facilitating hydration, sun safety, and minor first aid situations
 - o Assisting at lunchtime to ensure campers are eating an appropriate lunch
- Set up and clean-up equipment before and after programming, and ensure the camp is kept clean, organized, and free of litter
- Read and be comfortable with the Staff Handbook, including emergency procedures and safety guideline



The Camp Counsellor is to have the following experience and skills:

- A friendly and outgoing personality that makes you passionate about working with kids and are eager to make their camp experience a great one
- A creative approach to engaging, interacting and motivating kids to keep activities interesting and fun, and working through challenges that make them feel heard and protected
- A good understanding of athletic development in kids
- Energy and enthusiasm, bringing a positive energy to the camp everyday
- A strong work ethic that makes you reliable, punctual, professional and motivated
- Ability to work in a team environment as well as independently
- Experience with sports as a player, coach, or umpire is a plus
- Age 16+
